Apostrophes for Contraction



What are apostrophes for contraction?



The apostrophe for contraction is used when we shorten two words to make one word, for example do not becomes don't.

The apostrophe replaces the missing letters in the word; for example, in the word don't the apostrophe replaces the letter o in not.

Activity

Contract the two root words to form a single word. Replace any missing letters with an apostrophe.
